HINT OF THE DAY: To make it easy to access the Ossoli Circle website, you need to create a shortcut using the "Favorites" drop down list.

 First, open the Ossoli Circle website. You can type in our club name in the search engine like Google and several choices will appear. Click on the one that reads "GFWC Ossoli Circle, oldest Federated Woman's Club in the South". Or you can type in the web address: www.discoveret.org/gfwc-ossoli.

- 2. When you are on the Ossoli Circle home page, you will find the words "File, Edit, View, Favorites, Tools, Help" across the top of the screen. Click on Favorites, and a list of choices will drop down. Click Add to Favorites; then click Add. That's all you do.
- 3. Next time you want to visit the Ossoli Circle website, open your Internet browser, click on Favorites, and click on "GFWC Ossoli Circle, oldest Federated Woman's Club in the South" entry, and this will take you directly to our website. Easy as 1, 2, 3.
