UNICORN SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED

The Appalachian Assistance Committee of GFWC Ossoli Circle provides funds annually for scholarships in Morgan and Scott counties of Tennessee. Guidance counselors and school staff work with a committee from the Unicorn Fund Association in choosing two students from each of the two high schools in those counties to receive scholarships. The selections are made on the basis of scholastic achievement, family income and desire of student to achieve.

Additionally, the Unicorn Fund assists other needy students with tuition, books, fees, etc., in order to help them remain in school. Throughout the year, Ossoli Circle supports the resale shop, called Unicorn, located in Wartburg, with donations of clothing, household goods, appliances and other items. At Christmas members of Ossoli Circle fill and donate about 150 shoeboxes for distribution to the children in the area.

At the GFWC Ossoli Circle meeting on May 7, 2012, the Appalachian Assistance Committee presented the Unicorn fund Association checks for four scholarship awards for the coming academic year.
