Suffrage Reception

On Friday, June 8, 2018, members of GFWC Ossoli Circle served an amazing buffet to the attendees of the Suffrage Reception at the East Tennessee History Museum. On

Saturday afternoon, members wore white and marched in a parade down Gay Street to Market Square to celebrate the unveiling of the Harry Burn Memorial statue. After speeches by Mayor Madeline Roger and Wanda Sobieski, the crowd moved to a covered statue behind the Museum. The years of planning and fundraising had finally come to fruition, as the statue of Harry Burn and his mother Lib Burn was unveiled.

Harry holds the letter in his hand, written by his mother, which encouraged him to change his vote to "Yea", voting in favor of women's suffrage. Finally, the years of work, speeches, and even imprisonment achieved the goal---all women had the right to vote.
