OSSOLI IN ACTION PROJECT

Ossoli in Action working with the History Project of Knoxville produced an Art Wrap illustrating the Knoxville Female Institute by Russell Briscoe, a local artist painting of historic buildings. The founder of GFWC Ossoli Circle, Lizzie Crozier French (also pictured on the box), was the founder and teacher at the Institute popularly known as "Miss French's School". She and her sisters established it in 1881 for girls and young women in an era when they were excluded from colleges and schools of higher learning. This box is located across the street from the former site of the school where Church Street Methodist Church stands.
